

# I Certamen internacional de fotografía de ajedrez "Francesch Vicent" Segorbe 2017

The Chess Club "Alto Palancia" of Segorbe hosts the I Photography Contest "Francesch Vicent". Any person of legal age can participate, whether amateur or professional in photography. Contestants will participate using their own photographs, not awarded before and not presented in another contest prior to this contest.

This contest is included in the activities of the II International Festival "Francesch Vicent". Francesc Vicent was a genius and a master of chess. He was part of the group of innovative valencians, who at the end of the fifteenth century, changed forever the chess game. Francesc Vicent made a revolution in the rules of chess, the quintessence in the introduction of the almighty queen or lady. Francesch Vicent was originally from Segorbe and he was the author of the first modern chess treatise of the world (1495). The legacy of Francesc Vicent is immense. People play millions of games every day throughout the world using his rules, which have hardly undergone any variations for more than five centuries.

**THEME:** The subject of the photographs must be related to the Chess in any of its modalities, players in action, matches, championships, scenes or compositions that implicitly suggest or represent the world of chess.

**FORMAT:** The photographs will be presented in JPG digital format, weight maximum of 2 mb and maximum dimension in its longest side of 2400 pixels. Contestants can present up to 3 photographs. Photographies can be submitted both in black and white and in color, allowing the treatment of the image. Photographies showing some kind of mark, copyright or signature from a different author will not be admitted.

**DEADLINES:** The deadline for submission ends on July 1, 2017 by midnight. The awards ceremony will be held on July 15, 2017, 21 h, during the closing ceremony of the International Chess Days "Francesch Vicent", held at the hotel "Martín el Humano", Segorbe. The photographs must be sent from 6 March 2017 until 1 July 2017, through the digital platform "Digital Contests". [Http: // Www.concursosdigitales.com](http://www.concursosdigitales.com)

**PARTICIPATION RIGHTS:** € 10 per author, payment will be made by PayPal during the process of registration.

**JURY:** The jury will consist of three members having the faculty to resolve any unexpected contingency not provided earlier. Their decision will be unappealable.

**SELECTION:** Among all the works presented the jury will choose a total of 15 photographs that will pass to the final of winners.

**PRIZES:** Two prizes will be awarded

First prize: 300 Euros and a diploma

Second Prize: 100 Euros and a diploma.

A photographic exhibition will be organized for the 15 finalists in the hotel "Martín el Humano", where the closure of the of the International Chess Conference "Francesch Vicent" will be celebrated.

Participants cannot have the option for more than one prize.

**RIGHTS:** The winning photographs will be passed to the Chess Club

Alto Palancia, Segorbe. the faculties of use, diffusion, distribution,

public communication, exhibition and reproduction will be used for cultural activities and promotions that respond to our cultural activities, always indicating the name of the author in the photographs.

**ACCEPTANCE:** Participation implies the full acceptance of the rules of the contest and the final decision of the jury. The photographers will be responsible for the images taken regarding to the image rights of people, animals or objects photographed, and

those recognized in Organic Law 1/1982, of May 5, and the Article 18.1 of the Spanish Constitution. By taking part in the contest, the participants will expressly accept and respect the

rules of the contest. The rules of the contest can be corrected by the organization under unexpected circumstances as well as the interpretation of the organization without any appeal.
