REGULATIONS

The International Photographic Salon Sibiu 2012 is open to all the amateur and professional photographers from all over the world. The salon will be organized according to regulations and standards concerning the organization of the International Photographic Salons.

1. THEMES:

- a) BAROC (BAROQUE)
- b) OPEN

The theme of "Baroque" refers to photos that approaches the subject in the broad sense of the term, from the classic concept of arts history to the contemporary or experimental one. All photographic genre are included in the topic if they are created in the baroque spirit.

2. REQUIREMENTS:

The organizers will not accept photographs which have been exhibited in the previous editions of the Salon; An entry may be rejected when the sponsoring organization or its agent, in its reasonable discretion, believes the entry does not conform to exhibition rules and conditions; Each participant is allowed with a maximum number of 4 photographs for each theme; The works must be sent to orizontfoto@gmail.com, or on a digital support preferable on hard case CD/ DVD having the big side of maximum 2500 pixels, jpg format, 300 dpi resolution, or by mail to the address:

3. HOW TO NAME YOUR JPG IMAGE FILES:

RO-Popesculon-A1.jpg;

RO = ISO 3166 country code for Romania;

Popescu Ion = author's name and surname;

A1 - A4.jpg = the Section letter **A** and image number **(1-4)** of the entry;

B1 - B4.jpg = the Section letter **B** and image number **(1-4)** of the entry.

4. PARTICIPATION FEE:

Participation fee is mandatory for all participants of the exhibition and is 20 € (25 \$) for the two themes. The works of authors who do not pay participation fee will not be taken into consideration. Each author taking part in the exhibition and paying participation fee will receive the catalogue. The organizers will edit a CD which will contain all the works accepted in the contest. This can be purchased for 5 EURO or 6 USD at request.
